





Background Info. And Other Details

When the church's Come, Follow Me program officially started 4 years ago, our original plan was to share lessons and activities throughout the next 4 years and then be done creating new materials and just reuse the lesson plans we had already created for each book of scripture. However, earlier this year, a lady from the Cedar Fort LDS book publishing company contacted me to ask if I'd be interested in publishing something through them. After thinking it over, I decided it would be nice to have some new activities to use next year for our kids, ESPECIALLY if they were ones we could cut right out of a book so we wouldn't have to print up our own copies each week. So I talked to my talented sister Emily (who had just quit her job as a professional graphic designer to be a stay-at-home mom) and convinced her to design the pages and activities to look nice. I also talked my friend Crystal Wallace from theredcrystal.org into letting us use her artwork for some of the activities in the book. We worked hard and I studied the New Testament in SO much depth to create these activities. A few of them are repeat activities from when we taught the New Testament 4 years ago, but more than 80% of the content in the book is brand new.

If you don't want to purchase a physical book copy of the new lessons/activities, that's totally fine! All of the free lessons and activities we've posted for the past 4 years will still be available for free. 😊 We will also continue to create pages to send out that will include links to videos/songs/treats/etc. that go along with each new weekly lesson in 2023.
